






Creating a Memorable Identity




Conceptualized by Dawson Design Associates (DDA), every curve of Hotel Zena was designed to lead to another moment of discovery for those with the time to explore. Provocative art and design are at the core of Hotel Zena, where guests are immersed in over 60 pieces of gallery-quality art created specifically for Zena by a distinguished group of artists working globally for the cause of human rights. The art revolves around the courage of some of the world's most notable people and their fight for inclusivity and change. All the pieces are original and painted, photographed, sculpted and stitched by feminists of both genders with powerful stories to share.

Hotel Zena's exterior was designed by DC-based art director, muralist, designer, and illustrator Cita Sadeli, more popularly known as MISS CHELOVE. Her vision for Hotel Zena's mural was to create an atmosphere of intrigue composed of a pair of fierce yet curious warrior-sentinel women protecting the sanctity of the space.



Setting the Mood




The reception desk often serves as a focal point in a hotel's lobby area. It's one of the first things guests see when they enter the hotel, so it's an opportunity to make a strong visual impression and set the tone for the overall design.

Upon entering the lobby of Hotel Zena, you will realize in the best possible way that this is not your typical hotel. It's bright and colorful, and women are everywhere. "Jigsaw" is a sculpture of upcycled high heels at the hotel's reception desk making the first feminine statement.




Hosting an Immersive Guest Experience



Perhaps the most striking feature of the gallery is the massive Ruth Bader Ginsburg portrait. The "notorious" late Supreme Court Justice is immortalized in a portrait comprised of sustainably-made, handpainted tampons and bullets. The stunning pointillist portrait was created by Andrea Sheehan x Julie Coyle Art Associates.

Conceived by Andrea Sheehan, art director and founder of Dawson Design Associates who oversaw the hotel's design, the portrait is powerful, poignant, and made from 20,000 hand-painted tampons.




Storytelling

The art at Hotel Zena was created by artists from around the world. Its installations range from paintings to photography, sculptures, and textiles all with the goal of empowering women.




Supporting Local Artists



The main floor of the hotel is home to Figleaf, the hotel's signature restaurant, and The Portrait Gallery. The display gallery features portraits of influential women who have significantly shaped women's rights and gender equality.

In creating this space, the hotel provided a curated team of artists with a list of the 30 most all-time powerful women's rights activists. They also asked the artists to then select the subject with which they most connected, creating a portrait of them in whatever medium or style they saw fit.




Honoring to Reflect




Another unique installation is the hotel's "A Wall of Honor" that illuminates and features 221 individual charcoal-sketched portraits of men and women who have led the fight for women's rights, including Dolores Huerta, Florence Nightingale, Katherine Johnson, and Hillary Clinton to name a few. The Wall of Honor celebrates their lives, recognizes their sacrifices, and acknowledges their efforts to inspire the next generation to step forward and carry the torch.

It's an honor to walk amongst the path they paved for us.




Having Artful Touches




Hotel Zena's sleek collection of guestrooms and suites are styled for those that think as modern as they live. The art leaves room for contemplation with artful touches.


Sharing a Sneak Peek
